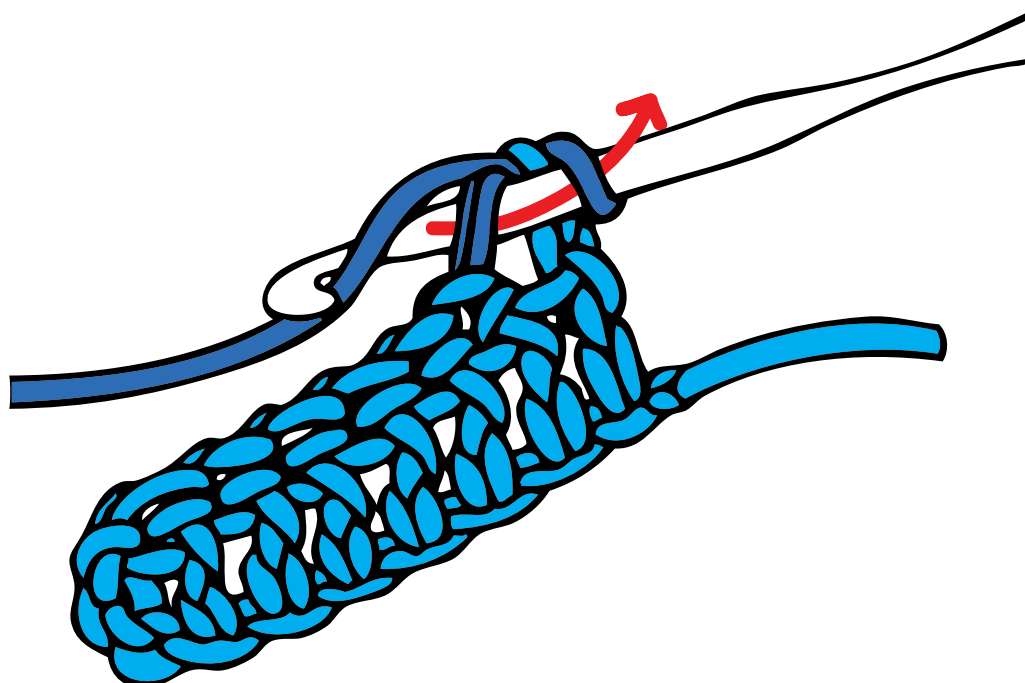
0.3_SLIP STITCH

The slip stitch is nearly invisible and it's usually used to finish a work or to close a line.

If you're brave enough to realize an entire project with this stitch, you will create a very firm and thick fabric, so you'd better use a bigger hook than the one suggested on the yarn label!

To realize it:

- Slip the hook in the second chain/stitch from the hook;
- Wrap the yarn over the hook and pull it directly through both the stitch you're and the loop on your hook.
- Repeat these movements until you reach the end of the line, then turn your work around, chain one and start again!
